## Health and Safety (Consultation with Employees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996

## Disapplication to sea-going ships and offshore installations

- 12.—(1) These Regulations shall not apply to or in relation to the master or crew of a sea-going ship or to the employer of such persons in respect of the normal ship-board activities of a ship's crew under the direction of the master.
- (2) These Regulations shall not apply to, or in relation to, an offshore installation to which the Offshore Installations (Safety Representatives and Safety Committees) Regulations 1989(1) apply.
- (3) In this regulation, the expression "offshore installation" has the same meaning as it has in regulation 3 of the Offshore Installations and Pipeline Works (Management and Administration) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995(2).
