**Food Labelling (Amendment)
Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1998**

Amendment of the Food Labelling Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1996

3. In regulation 2(1) (interpretation) after the definition of “confectionery product” there shall be inserted—

““Directive 79/112” means Council Directive [79/112/EEC\(1\)](#) on the approximation of the laws of the member States relating to the labelling, presentation and advertising of foodstuffs, as read in accordance with Schedule A1;

“Directive 87/250” means Commission Directive [87/250/EEC\(2\)](#) on the indication of alcoholic strength by volume in the labelling of alcoholic beverages for sale to the ultimate consumer;

“Directive 89/398” means Council Directive [89/398/EEC\(3\)](#) on the approximation of the laws of the member States relating to foodstuffs intended for particular nutritional uses;

“Directive 90/496” means Council Directive [90/496/EEC\(4\)](#) on nutrition labelling for foodstuffs;

“Directive 94/54” means Commission Directive [94/54/EEC\(5\)](#) concerning the compulsory indication on the labelling of certain foodstuffs of particulars other than those provided for in Directive 79/112, as amended by Council Directive [96/21/EC\(6\)](#)”.
