## Tuberculosis (Examination and Testing) Scheme (Northern Ireland) 1999

## Prohibition on testing, vaccination and treatment

- 6.—(1) A person, other than an authorised officer, shall not carry out a test on any bovine animal for tuberculosis.
- (2) A person, other than an authorised officer, shall not carry out a test on any non-bovine animal for tuberculosis without the permission of the Divisional Veterinary Officer for the area in which the animal is kept.
- (3) A person shall not vaccinate any animal against tuberculosis except in accordance with the conditions of a licence issued by the Department.
- (4) A person shall not treat any animal for tuberculosis except in accordance with the conditions of a licence issued by the Department.
  - (5) A licence issued under sub-paragraph (2), (3) or (4)—
    - (a) shall be in writing;
    - (b) may be granted subject to conditions; and
    - (c) may be modified, suspended or revoked by notice in writing given to the holder thereof at any time.
