PART B

Materials and workmanship

Interpretation

B1 In this Part—

HARMFUL SUBSTANCES includes fumes and vapours;

MATERIALS means any materials whether occurring naturally, recycled or manufactured; and

RELEVANT WORK means—

- (a) the erection of a building;
- (b) the structural alteration or extension of a building;
- (c) the provision of any service or fitting; or
- (d) the backfilling of any excavation carried out in connection with (a), (b) or (c).
