The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Article 164(5) of, and Schedule 7 to, the Children (Northern Ireland) Order 1995(1), hereby makes the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Children (Allocation of Proceedings) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2002 and shall come into operation on 9th December 2002.

Family Proceedings Courts

2. In Schedule 1 to the Children (Allocation of Proceedings) Order (Northern Ireland) 1996(**2**), for the word "Omagh" there shall be substituted the words "East Tyrone".
