Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2003

Prohibitions relating to certain substances

- **4.**—(1) Those substances described in Column 1 of Schedule 2 are prohibited to the extent set out in the corresponding entry in Column 2 of that Schedule.
- (2) A person shall not supply during the course of or for use at work any of the following substances or articles, namely—
 - (a) 2-naphthylamine, benzidine, 4-aminodiphenyl, 4-nitrodiphenyl, their salts and any substance containing any of those compounds in a total concentration equal to or greater than 0·1 per cent. by mass;
 - (b) matches made with white phosphorus.
- (3) A person shall not supply during the course of or for use at work, benzene or a substance containing benzene unless its intended use is not prohibited by item 11 of Schedule 2.
