# **COUNTY COURTS**

The County Court Fees (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2004

Made--21st December 2004Coming into operation6th January 2005

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 116(1) of the Judicature (Northern Ireland) Act 1978(1) after consultation with the Lord Chief Justice, and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:

#### Citation, commencement and interpretation

**1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the County Court Fees (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2004 and shall come into operation on 6th January 2005.

(2) In this Order "the principal Order" means the County Court Fees Order (Northern Ireland) 1996(2).

#### Amendments to the principal Rules

**2.** In Schedule 1 to the principal Order, there shall be substituted for the title to Section III, wherever it appears, the following new title –

"Fees to be taken in respect of proceedings under the Licensing (Northern Ireland) Order 1996, the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 and the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985"; and

3. After Fee no. 4 there shall be inserted the following new fee:

"5. On a notice of application to the court in relation to a bookmaking office licence (under Article 12(1) and Article 14(1) of the Betting, Gaming, Lotteries and Amusements (Northern Ireland) Order 1985 ...  $\pounds 216 \cdot 00$ ".
