## Fisheries Act (Northern Ireland) 1966(1)

1. In section 119 (temporary continuance of licence on death), for "widow" substitute "surviving spouse or civil partner".

- 2.—(1) In the definition of "relative" in Article 2(2) (interpretation), after "spouse" insert "or civil partner".
  - (2) In Article 100 (liability to maintain spouse and children)—
    - (a) in paragraph (1)(a) for "wife" substitute "spouse or civil partner",
    - (b) in paragraph (1)(b) for "husband" substitute "spouse or civil partner",
    - (c) in the heading to Article 100, after "spouse" insert "or civil partner".

5. In the definition of "civil partner" in Article 2(2) (interpretation), after "former civil partner" insert "and reputed civil partner".

6. In Article 4(8) ("Associate"), after "former civil partner" insert "and a reputed civil partner".
