# Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006

The Lord Chancellor makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 14, 22 and 27 of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981(a) and now vested in him(b):

#### Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006 and shall come into operation on 27th March 2006.

## Amendment to the principal regulations

**2.** In regulation 1(2) of the Legal Aid (Assessment of Resources) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1981(c) for "Department of Health and Social Services" substitute "Department for Social Development".
