**The Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs)
(Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2008**

Made - - - - 3rd June 2008

To be laid before Parliament

Coming into operation 1st July 2008

The Lord Chancellor makes the following Rules in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 36(3) of the Legal Aid, Advice and Assistance (Northern Ireland) Order 1981⁽¹⁾ and now vested in him⁽²⁾. In accordance with Article 36(3) of that Order, he has consulted with the Lord Chief Justice and the Attorney General and has obtained the approval of the Treasury.

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules may be cited as the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2008, and shall come into operation on 1st July 2008.

Alteration of date

2. In rules 6(3) and 9(5)(a) of the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) Rules (Northern Ireland) 1992⁽³⁾ for the date “30th June 2008” there shall be substituted the date “30th June 2010”.
