**Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008  
(Commencement No. 3 and Transitional Provisions) Order 2008**

*Made* - - - - *17th September 2008*

The Secretary of State makes the following Order, in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 1(4) and 100(4) of the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008(a):

**Citation and Interpretation**

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008 (Commencement No. 3 and Transitional Provisions) Order 2008.

(2) In this Order—

- (a) “the 2008 Order” means the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 2008; and
- (b) “the 1996 Order” means the Criminal Justice (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(b).

**Commencement**

2. The provisions of the 2008 Order specified in the Schedule to this Order shall come into operation on 6th October 2008.

**Transitional Provisions**

3. Any summons or warrant issued under Schedule 2 of the 1996 Order before the commencement of Article 47 of the 2008 Order shall continue to have effect under Schedule 2 of the 1996 Order as if Article 47 had not been commenced.
