**The Patient and Client Council (Membership and Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009**

**PART 1**

**GENERAL**

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Patient and Client Council (Membership and Procedure) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2009 and shall come into operation on 1st April 2009.

(2) In these regulations—

“the Act” means the Health and Social Care (Reform) Act (Northern Ireland) 2009;

“bankruptcy restrictions order” means an order made under Schedule 2A of the Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 1989<sup>(1)</sup> or Schedule 4A of the Insolvency Act 1986;

“charity trustee” means one of the persons having the general control and management of the administration of a charity;

<sup>(2)</sup>“debt relief restrictions order” means an order made under Schedule 2ZB to the Insolvency (Northern Ireland) Order 1989 or Schedule 4ZB to the Insolvency Act 1986;

<sup>(3)</sup>“former health service body” means a Strategic Health Authority, a Primary Care Trust<sup>(4)</sup>, the Health and Social Care Information Centre] or the Health Protection Agency;]

“health service body” means—

(a) any of the following within the meaning of the National Health Service Act 2006<sup>(2)</sup>—

“the Council” means the Patient and Client Council established under section 16 of the Act;  
“trade union” has the meaning assigned to it in Article 3 of the Industrial Relations (Northern Ireland) Order 1992(6);

“trustee for a charity” is a person not being a charity trustee, in whom legal title to the property of the charity is vested;

“voluntary organisation” shall have the same meaning as in the Order of 1972.
