**The Moy Road (Route A29) and Drumcairn Road, Armagh
(Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010**

Made - - - - - *16th August 2010*

Coming into operation - *20th October 2010*

The Department for Regional Development^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that the areas of road described in the Schedule are not necessary for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

No objection has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Moy Road (Route A29) and Drumcairn Road, Armagh (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2010 and shall come into operation on 20th October 2010.

Application

2. The areas of road described in the Schedule are abandoned.

Article 2

AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

An area of 556 square metres of superseded road at Moy Road, Armagh at its junction with Drumcairn Road, to the side of No. 1 Drumcairn Road and an area of 59.8 square metres of superseded road at Drumcairn Road, to the rear of No. 2 Abbey Park more particularly delineated and shown cross-hatched on Map No. 10/1/6/10.
