MISCELLANEOUS

Disapplication of certain statutory provisions following conversion decision

- 22. Where a conversion decision has been made in relation to any person, the following statutory provisions shall not apply to that person with effect from the conversion decision's effective date—
 - (a) sections 30A, [F130C,] 40 or 41 of the Contributions and Benefits Act(1) (incapacity benefit);
 - (b) section 68 of the Contributions and Benefits Act (severe disablement allowance)(2);
 - (c) regulation 13(2)(b) or (bb) of, or paragraph 7(a) or (b), 10, 12 or 13 of Schedule 1B to, the Income Support (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(3) (prescribed category of persons for the purposes of entitlement on grounds of incapacity or disability);
 - (d) the Income Support (Transitional) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1987(4); and
 - (e) the Social Security (Incapacity Benefit) (Transitional) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1995(5).
