The Food Hygiene (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010

Citation, commencement and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Food Hygiene (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2010 and come into operation on 13th April 2010.
- (2) The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954(1) shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to an Act of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Amendments to the Food Hygiene Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006

- **2.**—(1) The Food Hygiene Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006(2) are amended in accordance with paragraphs (2) and (3).
- (2) In regulation 2(1) (interpretation) for the references to the EU instruments appearing immediately after the definition of "the Community Regulations" there are substituted the following references—

- (3) For Schedule 1 (definitions of Community legislation) there is substituted the Schedule (definitions of EU legislation) set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.
