DESIGNATION OF LABORATORIES UNDER THE NORTHERN IRELAND POULTRY HEALTH ASSURANCE SCHEME

Designation of laboratories

13.—(1) The Department may designate any laboratory that it considers to be suitable for the purpose of carrying out Salmonella and Mycoplasma testing under the Northern Ireland Poultry Health Assurance Scheme.

(2) A laboratory must be accredited to ISO 17025 in order to be designated under the Scheme.

14. The Department may, by notice, suspend or revoke a designation granted to a laboratory under paragraph 13 where—

- (a) it considers that the laboratory cannot meet the conditions on which the designation was granted; or
- (b) if in its opinion the laboratory otherwise appears no longer suitable for the purposes of carrying out Salmonella and Mycoplasma testing under the Northern Ireland Poultry Health Assurance Scheme.
