**Fisheries Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2014**

**PART 16**

**ANNUAL CLOSE SEASONS AND CLOSE  
TIMES FOR COMMERCIAL FISHING**

- 64.**—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), a person shall not, on Lough Neagh –
- (a) take any coarse fish except pollen with a fishing engine, other than rod and line, during the period beginning on 1st March in any year and ending on 31st May in the same year, both dates inclusive; or
  - (b) take any coarse fish with a fishing engine, other than rod and line, during the period commencing at 6 a.m. on any Saturday and ending 6 a.m. on the next following Monday.
- (2) Paragraph (1)(a) shall not apply to the taking of coarse fish by means of a bait net by the holder of a licence for a long line for the taking of eels where such fish are for use solely as bait.
