The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019

 Coming into operation
 3rd June 2019

The Department for Infrastructure(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

## Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 3rd June 2019.

#### Amendment

**2.** The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016(**d**) is amended by the substitution for Part 2 of Schedule 2 of the following—

## "PART 2

No Waiting at any time — Loading and unloading not permitted

- 1. Castle Street (east side) from a point 15 metres north-east of its junction with the A2 Marine Highway to its junction with High Street.
- 2. High Street (east side) from its junction with Castle Street to a point 100 metres south-west of its junction with Antrim Street.
- 3. Rodgers Quay (north-east side) from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with the A2 Belfast Road for a distance of 28 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 4. Rodgers Quay (south-west side) from a point 15 metres south-east of its junction with the A2 Belfast Road for a distance of 52 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 5. Victoria Road (west side) from a point 15 metres north of its junction with Prince Andrew Way for a distance of 36 metres in a northerly direction.
- 6. Victoria Road (west side) from a point 88.5 metres north of its junction with Prince Andrew Way for a distance of 77.5 metres in a northerly direction."

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Carrickfergus) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 ("the Order") by the addition of a 'no waiting at any time – loading and unloading not permitted' restriction on the lengths of Victoria Road specified in Article 2 and the deletion of a 'no waiting at any time' restriction on a shorter length of Victoria Road.

Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
