# The Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty) (Amendment) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020

Made---19th June 2020Coming into operation-10th July 2020

The Department of Health(**a**), in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(4) and 297(3), paragraph 5(1)(a) of Schedule 1, paragraph 1(2) and 3(1)(a) of Schedule 2 and paragraph 3(1)(a) of Schedule 3 to the Mental Capacity Act (Northern Ireland)  $2016(\mathbf{b})$ , makes the following Regulation:

### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty) (Amendment) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020 and shall come into operation on 10th July 2020.

#### Revocation

**2.** The Mental Capacity (Deprivation of Liberty) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020 are revoked.
