The Social Security (Coronavirus) (Further Measures) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020

Expiry

10.—(1) The Secretary of State must keep the operation of these Regulations under review.

(2) Regulations [$^{F1}6$ and 7] cease to have effect at the end of the period of eight months beginning on 13th March 2020.

[^{F2}(2A) Regulation 2 ceases to have effect on [^{F3}31st July 2021].

(2B) Regulations 8 and 9 cease to have effect on [^{F4}31st August 2021].]

(3) Regulation 3 (treating a person as having limited capability for work) and regulation 4 (suspension of the minimum income floor) of the Employment and Support Allowance and Universal Credit (Coronavirus) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2020^{MI} no longer have effect in so far as they apply to Universal Credit.
