Amendment of the Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2021

5. In regulation 5(1)-

- (a) after “A person responsible for carrying on a business or a members’ club which sells or provides food or drink (whether or not including intoxicating liquor) for consumption on the premises” insert “(other than premises to which paragraph (3) applies)”;
- (b) omit head (f)(iii);
- (c) in subparagraph (fa) omit “is recorded and that it”;
- (d) omit subparagraph (g);
- (e) in head (h)(ii) omit “background or ambient”; and
- (f) for subparagraph (n) substitute-
 - “(n) must not permit a customer to move within the premises other than to
 - (i) enter or exit the premises, access a table, make a payment, access a buffet or carvery, or access and use toilet, baby changing or breast feeding facilities or a smoking area, or
 - (ii) visit a place where a marriage ceremony or civil partnership ceremony may lawfully take place, for the purposes of viewing the facilities, provided that the gathering includes no more than four visitors and one member of staff of the place and that there is no more than one such visit at any one time.”
