EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM TO

The Rockfield Park, Portaferry (Abandonment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021

S.R. 2021 No. 310

1. Introduction

- 1.1. This Explanatory Memorandum has been prepared by the Department for Infrastructure to accompany the Statutory Rule (details above) which is laid before the Northern Ireland Assembly.
- 1.2. The Statutory Rule is made under Article 68(1), and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993 and is subject to the negative resolution procedure.

2. Purpose

- 2.1. The purpose of the rule is to abandon an area of 72 square metres of road comprising part of a former turning head adjacent to No. 31 Rockfield Park, Portaferry.
- 2.2. On the coming into operation of the rule, the area of road in question shall cease to be maintainable by the Department and the public right of way over it shall be extinguished.

3. Background

3.1. The abandonment has been requested by a local housing developer in order to facilitate further housing development in the area. Following an assessment the Department considered that a new footpath should be constructed to provide alternative facilities for pedestrians, and on completion of those works the area of road will be abandoned.

4. Consultation

- 4.1. The PSNI has been consulted and no objection has been received. Ards and North Down Borough Council has also been advised of the proposed abandonment but no acknowledgement has been received.
- 4.2. A notice in respect of the proposed abandonment was published in the local press for two successive weeks, a notice was posted on site and the statutory undertakers were notified of the proposal. No objections were received.

5. Equality Impact

5.1. Consideration has been given to compliance with section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998. No equality issues have been identified by the Department and no issues were raised following the publication of the notice in the press.

6. Regulatory Impact

6.1. A Regulatory Impact Assessment was not considered necessary as the proposal does not result in any costs or savings to business, charities or the voluntary bodies.

7. Financial Implications

7.1. The applicant has signed an undertaking to reimburse the Department's costs and expenses and to pay any compensation due as a result of making the Rule.
