Regulation 2

Notice of licence conditions

It is an offence to sell, or make available for purchase, intoxicating liquor or permit it to be consumed in a licensed restaurant unless:

- (a) it is sold for consumption and is consumed –
 - (i) as ancillary to a main table meal; and
 - (ii) in a part of the restaurant set apart for the service of such meals or for the service of intoxicating liquor and other beverages to diners before or after such meals; and
- (b) it is paid for at the same time, and on the same bill, as the meal; and
- (c) suitable beverages other than intoxicating liquor (including drinking water) are also made available for consumption; and
- (d) no payment is made by way of an entrance fee to the premises containing the restaurant.
