# The Agriculture (Student Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2024

Made - - - - 16th May 2024

Coming into operation 1st September 2024

The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs(a), in exercise of the powers conferred by section 5A(1) and (2) of the Agriculture Act 1949(b), makes the following Regulations.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Agriculture (Student Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2024 and shall come into operation on the 1st September 2024.

# Amendment to the Agriculture (Student Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023

**2.** In the Agriculture (Student Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2023(c), for the table of fees in Schedule 1 (student fee amounts), substitute the table as follows -
