## LUNATIC ASYLUM. Books and Records.

MADE BY THE INSPECTORS OF LUNATICS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1898 TO 1923, AND ALL OTHER POWERS ON THAT BEHALF, AMENDING THE ASYLUM BOOKS AND RECORDS ORDER, 1900, AND THE ASYLUM BOOKS AND RECORDS (AMENDING) ORDER, 1902, IN SO FAR AS THE REGULATIONS REGARDING THE CAPITATION GRANT IN AID OF THE MAINTENANCE OF PAUPER LUNATICS ARE CONCERNED.

#### 1924. No. 50.

Whereas the Inspectors of Lunatics in Ireland, in pursuance of the powers vested in them by The Asylum Accounts Order, 1899, and by any Orders made by the Local Government Board enabling them in that behalf, did on the 19th day of March, 1900, make an Order entitled "The Asylum Books and Records Order, 1900." And whereas by reason of the passing of the Lunacy (Ireland) Act, 1901 (1 Edw. VII., cap. 17), it became necessary to make certain changes in the Order aforesaid ;

And whereas the said Inspectors accordingly made a further Order entitled "The Asylum Books and Records (Amending) Order, 1902."

And whereas certain alterations in the method of paying the Grant in aid of the maintenance of Pauper Lunatics have been made by the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1923.

Now, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland by the Local Government Acts (Northern Ireland) 1898 to 1923, and of all other powers in that behalf, it is hereby ordered :---

Article (1). This Order shall be known and cited as "The Asylum Books and Records (Third Amending) Order, 1924."

Article (2). The following Articles and parts thereof contained in the Orders aforesaid shall be revoked as from the date of this Order, viz. :---

In the Asylum Books and Records Order, 1900 :--

That part of Article 2 which defines the expression "Capitation Grant";

The last clause (10) of Article 5;

The whole of Article 6.

The reference to Form No. 35 (Capitation Grant Return) at foot of List of Forms in the Schedule.

# METALLIFEROUS MINES AND QUARRIES. First Aid Box or Cupboard.

ORDER, DATED 29TH MAY, 1924, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE MINING INDUSTRY ACT, 1920 (10 & 11 GEO. 5. C. 50), FACTORY AND WORKSHOP ACTS, 1901 TO 1920, AND SECTION 26 (1) OF THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 (13 & 14 GEO. 5. CH. 33), PRESCRIBING THE EQUIP-MENT FOR FIRST-AID AT QUARRIES AND PITBANKS OF METALLIFEROUS MINES.

#### 1924. No. 47.

In pursuance of Sub-section (1) of Section 26 of the Workmen's Compensation Act (Northern Ireland), 1923 (hereinafter called "the said Sub-section"), and under the provisions of the Mining Industry Act, 1920, as that Act applies in Northern Ireland, the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland hereby prescribes that at every Quarry and every Pitbank of a mine under the Metalliferous Mines Regulation Acts, 1872 and 1875 (35-6 V. c. 77 and 38-9 V. c. 39) being a Quarry or Pitbank to which the said Sub-section applies, the first-aid box or cupboard required by the said Sub-section to be provided and maintained shall comply with the following standard :—
