# THE STATUTORY RULES AND ORDERS OF A GENERAL CHARACTER

### ISSUED IN 1925.

## BUSINESS NAMES, REGISTRATION OF, Rules.

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 17 OF THE REGISTRATION OF BUSINESS NAMES ACT, 1916 (6 & 7 GEO. 5, C. 58), AND RELATED ORDER MADE BY THE MIN-ISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE PUBLIC OFFICES FEES ACT, 1879.

#### 1925.No. 27.

1. The following Rule shall, as respects Northern Ireland, be substituted for Rule II of the Business Names Rules, 1917 (a) as altered by the Business Names Rules, 1921 (b).

### Fees.

- II (1). The fees to be paid to the Registrar in Northern Ireland under the Act are to be as follows:-
  - (a) On a Statement of Particulars required by Section 3 of the Act the sum of five shillings, and such fee shall cover the issue of one certificate of registration:
  - On any Statement of Particulars required by the Schedule to the Act when such particulars are not furnished with the Statement of Particulars required by Section 3 of the Act the sum of five shillings, and such fee shall cover the issue of one certificate of registration;
  - On a statement of any change within the meaning of Section 6 of the Act the sum of five shillings, and such fee shall cover the issue of one certificate of the registration of such statement;
  - (d) By any person inspecting under the provisions of Section 16 of the Act the documents filed by the Registrar, the sum of one shilling for each inspection;
  - On the application of any person requiring under the provisions of Section 16 of the Act a certificate of registration of any firm, individual or corporation, the sum of two shillings;
  - (f)On the application of any person requiring a copy of or extract from any registered statement whether certified or uncertified the sum of sixpence for each folio of seventy-two words in addition to an inspection fee of one shilling;

- (g) By any person appealing to the Ministry of Commerce from a decision of the Registrar the sum of one pound.
- 2. The said fees shall be collected in the manner directed by the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland in the order subjoined to these Rules, and the forms prescribed by the Business Names Rules, 1917, as those Rules apply in Northern Ireland shall be construed accordingly.

These Rules may be cited as the Business Names Rules (Northern Ireland), 1925, and shall come into operation on the first day of April, 1925.

## CENSUS OF PRODUCTION. Exempted Trades and Industries.

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CENSUS OF PRODUCTION ACT, 1906 (6 EDW. 7, c. 49).

1925. No. 46.

Whereas by virtue of Section 8 of the Census of Production Act, 1906, (6 Edw. 7, c. 49), the Directions of the Lord Lieutenant dated 7th June, 1921, the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, and the General Adaptation of Enactments (Northern Ireland) Order, 1921, the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland may make rules:—

(a) for prescribing, either generally or as respects any particular industry or class of industries, anything which, under the Census of Production Act, 1906, is to be prescribed; and
