MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND
UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT, 1920 (10 &
11 GEO. 5, c. 30).

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Sections 35 and 47 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, as adapted to Northern Ireland by the Government of Ireland (Adaptation of Unemployment Insurance Acts) Order, 1922, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following regulations :—

1. The period commencing on the 6th day of July, 1925 (being the day next after the last day of the preceding Insurance Year) and ending on the 4th day of July, 1926, shall be an Insurance Year.

2. These regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Year) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1925, and shall come into force on the date hereof.

Repayment and Return of Contributions.

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND

(NO. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1924 (14 AND 15 GEO.
5, c. 25).

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the Unemployment Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations for amending the Unemployment Insurance (Repayment and Return of Contributions) Regulations, 1920, hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Regulations" :—

1. At the end of Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations there shall be inserted the words following :—

“ Provided also that the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland may repay to the employer instead of to the employed person the contributions erroneously paid by the employer on behalf of the employed person and not recovered from him.”

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Repayment and Return of Contributions) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1925, and shall have effect as from the first day of August, 1924.

Subsidiary Employments.

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as “the Ministry”) in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by paragraph (j) of Part 2 of the First Schedule to the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920 (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and the said Ministry, in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Sub-Section 1 of Section 4 of the Act and with the consent of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland hereby orders as follows :—

1. The employments of the several classes specified in the First Schedule to the Special Order made under the National Health Insurance Act, 1924, set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby declared by the Ministry to be employments of such a nature that they are ordinarily adopted as subsidiary employment only and not as the principal means of livelihood and the said Special Order is hereby declared by the Ministry to apply for the purpose of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920.

2. Persons engaged in the several classes of employment specified in the Second Schedule to the Special Order made under the National Health Insurance Act, 1924, set out in the Schedule
