MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 7 OF THE GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 2 OF THE ELECTRICITY AND GAS (EXPENSES) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923.

The said Ministry hereby prescribes that:—

- (1) The rate of payment to the Ministry of Commerce for the year 1926 shall be one shilling and threepence for each million cubic feet of gas sold during the year 1925.
- (2) Such payments shall, on or before the 1st April, 1926, be made to the Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland at 13 Wellington Place, Belfast, by any Gas Undertakers in Northern Ireland with respect to whom an Order under the said Act shall have been made, by cheque made payable to the "Secretary, Ministry of Commerce."

HORSE BREEDING (NORTHERN IRELAND) RULE, 1926.

Made by the Ministry of Agriculture of Northern Ireland under the Horse Breeding Act [N.I.], 1926.

1926. No. 121.

The Ministry of Agriculture by virtue and in exercise of the power for this purposes vested in it by the Horse Breeding Act (Northern Ireland), 1926, and of every other power in that behalf enabling it, hereby determines the Seventh day of December, 1926, as the "Appointed Day" for the purposes of the provisions of that Act enabling applications for Licences or permits to be made to, or rules to be made by, the Ministry of Agriculture and authorising the inspection and examination of stallions, the entry of premises and the granting of Licences and Permits.
