

Motor Vehicles (Traffic and Regulation) Act (Northern Ireland), 1926, nothing in this Regulation shall authorise any such vehicle to stop to take up or set down passengers except at such prescribed stopping places.

- (8) The principal Regulations shall be read and have effect as if in Article 2 (a) the words " which shall include the premises of a railway station " were inserted after the words " public place."
- (9) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1928, and shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations.
- (10) These Regulations shall come into force on the Seventeenth day of December, 1928.

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### Roads Improvement: General Regulations.

THE ROADS IMPROVEMENT REGULATIONS, 1928, DATED THE 20TH JULY, 1928, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS.

1928. No. 72.

To the Council of each Administrative County in Northern Ireland :

To the Council of each Urban District in Northern Ireland ; and  
To all others whom it may concern :

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Roads Improvement Act (Northern Ireland), 1928, and of every other power in this behalf enabling the Ministry hereby makes and prescribes the following Regulations :—

#### *Preliminary.*

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Roads Improvement Regulations, 1928.

2. In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires :—
- (a) The expression “the Ministry” means the Ministry of Home Affairs.
  - (b) The expression “the Act” means the Roads Improvement Act (Northern Ireland), 1928.

*Prohibition or Restriction of the Driving of  
Vehicles on Roads.*

3.—(1) A local authority at least one week before making an order prohibiting or restricting the driving of vehicles on any road pursuant to Section 5 of the Act shall publish notice of the proposal to make such order once at least in one or more of the newspapers circulating in the locality in which such road is situate, and shall cause copies of the said notice to be posted on or near the outer door of their offices and on a notice board erected in a conspicuous position at or near each end of the said road and on such other places on or in the neighbourhood of the said road as they may consider necessary so as to give due publicity to the matter. The notice shall state clearly the effect of the proposed order.

(2) The local authority shall cause notice of the making of the order to be published and posted in the manner provided for the publishing and posting of notices by the preceding sub-article. The notice shall state clearly the effect of the order, the penalties for contravention thereof and the time within which any aggrieved person may appeal to the Ministry. During the time the order remains in operation a notice board with a notice stating clearly the effect of the order shall be kept erected in a conspicuous position at or near each end of the road affected.

(3) The local authority shall publish notice of any decision of the Ministry given pursuant to Section 5 of the Act in one or more of the newspapers circulating in the locality in which the road affected is situate.

4. A person aggrieved by an order made by a local authority pursuant to Section 5 of the Act may appeal to the Ministry against the order within one month from the giving of public notice thereof. The appellant shall within the said period send notice of appeal in writing to the Ministry, which notice shall contain a full statement of all the facts and circumstances which he may desire to lay before the Ministry in support of his appeal and he shall at the same time send a copy of the notice to the local authority.

*Compulsory Acquisition of Land for Road Purposes.*

5. An application by a local authority for a vesting order shall be in the Form No. 1 in the Schedule hereto or in a form to the like effect and shall have attached thereto a map or plan indicating clearly the lands proposed to be acquired.

6.—(1) Notice of the application shall be published once at least in each of two successive weeks in one or more of the newspapers circulating in the locality in which the lands proposed to be acquired are situate.

(2) Notice of the application shall be given to the owners, lessees and occupiers of the said lands—(a) by delivery of the same personally to the person to whom such notice is required to be given or by delivering it or leaving it at the usual or last known place of abode of such person, or (b) by sending the same by post as a registered letter addressed to such person at his usual or last known place of abode; or (c) if that cannot be found, by affixing it on some conspicuous part of the lands proposed to be acquired.

(3) Where the lands are subject to any annuity under the Land Purchase Acts notice of the application shall be given to the Ministry of Finance. Such notice shall be given by delivery of the same at the offices of the Ministry of Finance, 15 Donegall Square West, Belfast, or by sending the same by post as a registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Finance, at the said address.

(4) The notice shall state clearly the nature of the application, the lands proposed to be acquired and the time within which objections to the application must be sent to the Ministry and the notice given to any owner, lessee or occupier of the lands or to the Ministry of Finance shall have attached thereto a map or plan sufficient to enable the person to whom it is given to identify the lands proposed to be acquired.

7. Notice of the making of a vesting order shall be published and shall be given to the owners, lessees and occupiers of the lands to which it relates in the same manner as notice of the application is required to be published and given by the preceding article and shall also be given to the Ministry of Finance where notice of the application is required to be given to that Ministry.

8. The receipt to be given to the local authority for the compensation paid by them shall be in the Form No. 2 in the Schedule hereto or in a form to the like effect.

9. The statutory declaration to be made by a person to whom the compensation payable does not exceed the sum of £100 shall be in the Form No. 3 in the schedule hereto or in a form to the like effect.
