

Public Elementary Schools : Salaries and Capitation Grants.

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH MARCH, 1931, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, NORTHERN IRELAND, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, NORTHERN IRELAND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AND PRESENTED TO BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 99 (2) OF THE ACT AFORESAID.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, the Ministry of Education, Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as the Ministry) after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. All amounts payable to or on behalf of teachers of public elementary schools (including public elementary schools conducted by religious communities) under the heads of—

- (a) Salaries ;
- (b) Bonuses for principal and assistant teachers with special qualifications ; and
- (c) Normal and special capitation grants and special payments on account of certain lay assistants to schools conducted by religious communities and paid on the capitation system ;

in accordance with the provisions of the Salaries and Capitation Grants (Public Elementary Schools) Regulations, 1929 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1929, No. 55) as amended by Statutory Rules and Orders, 1929, No. 88, and 1930, Nos. 55 and 148, or in accordance with the provisions of the Salaries and Capitation Grants (compensated Model School Teachers) Regulations, 1927 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1927, No. 53), shall be and are hereby reduced by seven and one-half per cent. in respect of all services rendered or performed on and after the 1st day of April, 1931, within the meaning and application of the said respective Statutory Rules and Orders, and the said Statutory Rules and Orders and each of them shall be deemed to be and are hereby amended to the extent necessary to give effect to these regulations.

2. These regulations shall have effect until further notice, and may be revoked or amended at any time.

3. In case of doubt or dispute as to the meaning and effect of the foregoing regulations, the decision of the Ministry thereon shall be final.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Salaries and Capitation Grants (Public Elementary Schools) Interim Regulations, 1931.

REGULATIONS, DATED 24TH SEPTEMBER, 1931, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, NORTHERN IRELAND, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, NORTHERN IRELAND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AND PRESENTED TO BOTH HOUSES OF PARLIAMENT IN PURSUANCE OF SECTION 99 (2) OF THE ACT AFORESAID.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, the Ministry of Education, Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as the Ministry) after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. The Salaries and Capitation Grants (Public Elementary Schools) Interim Regulations, 1931 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations) are hereby amended by the insertion of the following heading in Article 1, after heading (c) :—

“(d) Annual Capitation grants ;”

2. These Regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations, and shall take and have effect from the same date as the Principal Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Regulations (No. 1) Amending the Salaries and Capitation Grants (Public Elementary Schools) Interim Regulations, 1931.
