REGULATIONS, DATED 25TH MARCH, 1931, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE EXCHEQUER AND FINANCIAL PROVISIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 (13 GEO. 5, CH. 4) AND THE EXCHEQUER AND FINANCIAL PROVISIONS (NO. 2) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1930 (20 & 21 GEO. 5, CH. 17).

WHEREAS certain Regulations entitled "the Reserve Fund (Capital Liabilities) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1929," were made by the Ministry of Finance on 30th September, 1929, in pursuance of sub-section (2) of section two of the Exchequer and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, and by Regulations 3 and 4 thereof, provision was made with respect to certain liabilities of the Northern Irish Unemployment Fund under the Unemployment Insurance (Agreement) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1926 and 1929 :

And whereas different provision with respect to the said liabilities has been made by section two of the Exchequer and Financial Provisions (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, and by reason thereof the said Regulations 3 and 4 have ceased to have effect :

Now, the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Exchequer and Financial Provisions Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, and the Exchequer and Financial Provisions (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, hereby revokes Regulations 3 and 4 of the Reserve Fund (Capital Liabilities) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1929.

Ulster Savings Certificates.

MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, UNDER SECTION 1 (2) OF THE EXCHEQUER BORROWING AND LOCAL LOANS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1922.

The Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers vested in the said Ministry by sub-section (2) of

section one of the Exchequer Borrowing and Local Loans Act (Northern Ireland), 1922, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. Article 6 (1) of the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations, 1927, shall in its application to Certificates issued on or after the first day of May, 1931, be amended so as to read as follows :—

“ 6.—(1) The amount repayable in respect of a single certificate shall be as follows :—

“ Within twelve months from date of purchase twelve shillings and sixpence.

“ After twelve months from date of purchase twelve shillings and nine pence.

“ And thereafter with the further addition of two pence in respect of each four months of the next four years from the date of purchase; two pence for each three months of the next four years, three pence for each four months of the remaining three years of currency, and a bonus of four pence on the twelfth anniversary.”

2. These Regulations may be cited as Ulster Savings Certificates (Amendment) Regulations, 1931, and shall be construed as one with the Ulster Savings Certificates Regulations, 1927.

FISHERIES.

Net Fishing in Belfast Lough.

1931. No. 16.

WHEREAS, by By-Laws bearing date the Twentieth day of April, One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-Four, it was provided as follows, viz. :—

1. The method of Fishing known as Trawling is hereby prohibited at all times in that part of Belfast Lough inside, or to the Westward and Southward, of an imaginary line drawn from Whiteabbey in the County of Antrim, in a S.E. direction to Holywood in the County of Down.
