REGULATIONS, DATED THE 4TH DAY OF APRIL, 1932, AMENDING THE SECONDARY SCHOOL EXAMINATIONS REGULATIONS MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND DULY LAID BEFORE PARLIAMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1923 TO 1931.

1932. No. 31.

1. These Regulations may be cited as "The Secondary School Examinations Regulations, Amending Regulations No. 1."

2. The Secondary School Examinations Regulations (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations") are hereby amended, the following paragraph being added to Regulation 46 thereof :---

"(b) A Secondary School Certificate destroyed or otherwise lost by a candidate will not be replaced by the Ministry, but the Ministry may at any time furnish to a candidate or to any person on his behalf, whether that candidate obtained a Certificate or not, a certified statement of the result of his examination, together with the marks which he obtained therein, upon payment of a fee of one shilling."

3. These Regulations shall come into operation and have effect on 1st May, 1932, and shall thenceforth be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.
