THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE (DEPOSIT CONTRIBUTORS) AMENDMENT (NO. 2) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1932, DATED 18TH JUNE, 1932, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) 1924 TO 1931.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland acting jointly and in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1924 to 1931, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations:—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1932, and shall be read as one with the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1930, \*(hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”), and the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1932, †(hereinafter referred to as the “Amending Regulations”).

2. The provisions of Section 1 of the National Health Insurance (No. 2) Act (Northern Ireland), 1931—which Act is by Section 4

(2) thereof to be construed as one with the National Health Insurance Act, 1924—shall apply, as modified and set out in the manner following, to deposit contributors :—

(1) Where a person being a deposit contributor was immediately before the first day of January, 1932, insured as an employed contributor under the provisions of paragraph (4) of Article 5 of the principal Regulations, or under Article 3 of the Amending Regulations, he shall continue to be treated as an employed contributor remaining, by virtue of the said paragraph (4), insured under the Act until the thirty-first day of December, 1932, if he proves within the period specified in paragraph (2) of this Article that throughout the period during which by virtue of the said paragraph (4) or the said Article 3, he remained insured under the Act, he was, when not employed, either available for but unable to obtain employment or incapable of work by reason of some specific disease or bodily or mental disablement of which notice was given within the time specified in paragraph (2) of this Article.

(2) For the purpose of paragraph (1) of this Article the time within which a deposit contributor is required—

(a) to prove that throughout the period mentioned in the said paragraph (1) he was, when not employed, either available for but unable to obtain employment, or incapable of work, or

(b) to give notice of the disease or disablement,

shall in each case be the period ending on the date six months after the date on which he would, but for the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article, have ceased to be insured under the provisions of paragraph (4) of Article 5 of the principal Regulations, or under Article 3 of the Amending Regulations.

Provided that—

- (i) the Ministry, if satisfied that there is in any particular case reasonable ground for doing so, may extend the period by such further period, not being more than six months, as the Ministry may determine, and
- (ii) any disease or disablement in respect of which sickness or disablement benefit is payable by virtue of the proviso to sub-section (4) of Section 13 of the Act, or would in the opinion of the Ministry, had the insured person not been otherwise disqualified, have been so payable, shall be deemed to be a disease or disablement of which notice was given within the prescribed time; so, however, that where benefit is or would be payable under the said proviso up to a date earlier than that on which notice was given, notice shall be deemed to have been given within the prescribed time only as respects the period up to the last day for which benefit is or

would be so payable, and the incapacity for work by reason of any disease or disablement in respect of which notice is deemed to have been given within the prescribed time shall be deemed to have been proved within the prescribed time.

These Regulations shall be deemed to have had effect as from the first day of January, 1932.

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### Disposal of Balances.

REGULATIONS, DATED 31ST MARCH, 1932, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1924 TO 1931.

1932. No. 29.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland in pursuance of the powers conferred on it by Section 17 of the National Health Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, and with the consent of the Ministry of Finance hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Disposal of Balances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1932, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1930, except as otherwise expressly provided.

2.—(1) In these Regulations :—

“ the Ministry ” means the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland.

“ the Act of 1930 ” means the National Health Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1930.
