## Appointed Days.

APPOINTED DAY FOR THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE MARKETING OF EGGS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936.

> 1936. No. 105.

WHEREAS by Section 17 of the Marketing of Eggs Act (Northern Ireland) 1936, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") it is provided that the Act shall come into operation on the appointed day and that the appointed day for the purposes of the Act shall be such day as the Minister of Agriculture may appoint and that different days may be appointed for different purposes and different provisions of the Act:

And whereas it is expedient that the Egg Marketing Committee for Northern Ireland be established in accordance with Section three of the Act and that a day be appointed for the coming into operation of such provisions of the Act as may be necessary for the purpose of the establishment of the said Committee:

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Sir Basil Stanlake Brooke, Bart., Minister of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, hereby appoint the thirtieth day of July, 1936, to be the appointed day for the coming into operation of such provisions of the Act as are necessary for the purpose of the establishment of the Egg Marketing Committee for Northern Ireland.
