# THE IMPORTATION OF PLANTS (NORTHERN IRELAND) (AMEND-MENT NO. 2) ORDER OF 1936, DATED 16TH DECEMBER, 1936.

### 1936. No. 173.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Destructive Insects and Pests Acts (Northern Ireland) 1877 to 1934, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows :---

## Modification of the Importation of Plants Order (Northern Ireland) of 1933.

1. The Importation of Plants Order (Northern Ireland) of 1933 (herein referred to as "the principal Order") as modified by the Importation of Plants (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Orders of 1934, 1935 and 1936 (herein referred to as "the Orders of 1934 and 1935 and 1936") is hereby further modified in the manner provided by this Order.

# Restriction on the Landing in Northern Ireland of plants, potatoes, raw vegetables and cider apples grown in Germany or Luxemburg.

2. The provisions of the Importation of Plants (Northern Ireland) (Amendment) Order of 1936 with respect to plants, potatoes, raw vegetables and eider apples grown in Belgium shall apply to plants, potatoes, raw vegetables and eider apples grown in Germany or Luxemburg, provided that such provisions shall be applied as if where the words "Belgium" and "Belgian" occur in such Order, including the First Schedule thereto, there were substituted in the case of plants, potatoes, raw vegetables and eider apples grown in Germany the words "Germany" and "German" respectively, and in the case of plants, potatoes, raw vegetables and eider apples grown in Luxemburg the word

### Commencement. .

3. This Order shall come into operation on the eleventh day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven.

#### Short Title and Construction.

4. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Plants (Northern Ireland) (Amendment No. 2) Order of 1936 and shall be read as one with the principal Order and the Orders of 1934 and 1935 and 1936, and those Orders and this Order may be cited together as the Importation of Plants (Northern Ireland) Orders of 1933 to 1936.
