And whereas it appears to the Ministry to be desirable that the Petty Sessions districts of Gortin and Newtownstewart, County Tyrone, shall be served by one and the same person as Petty Sessions Clerk :

Now, therefore, the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 11 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, hereby orders as follows :—

From and after the 22nd day of February, 1938, the Petty Sessions districts of Gortin and Newtownstewart, County Tyrone, shall be served by one and the same person as Petty Sessions Clerk.

This Order may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction (Petty Sessions districts) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland), 1937.

ORDER, DATED 29TH DECEMBER, 1937, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (N.I.), 1935.

1937. No. 142.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs, as follows :—

As and from the 7th day of February, 1938,

1. The townlands set forth in column 2 of the First Schedule to this Order constituting the Petty Sessions District as set out in column 1 of the said Schedule shall be added to the Petty Sessions Districts set out in column 3 of the said Schedule.

2. The Petty Sessions District named in column 1 of the Schedule shall be abolished.

3. The times when Petty Sessions shall be regularly held in the districts set out in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be as set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite the names of each of such Petty Sessions Districts.
