

REGULATIONS DATED 1ST APRIL, 1938, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND WITH THE CONSENT OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 2 OF THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1938.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 2 of the Unemployment Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1938, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the consent of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Insurable Employments) (Agriculture) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1938, and shall come into force on the 4th April, 1938.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to the Unemployment Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1936 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), shall be construed as a reference to that Act as amended by any order or subsequent enactment.

2.—There shall be included among the classes of persons employed in insurable employment the classes of persons set out in the Schedule hereto (being persons employed wholly or mainly out of doors in an excepted employment in domestic service) when employed as therein set forth, so, however, that these Regulations shall not affect the operation of Part II of the First Schedule to the Act or of Part III of that Schedule or of any Regulations made under section 3 of the Act.

## SCHEDULE.

CLASSES OF PERSONS TO BE INCLUDED AMONG THE CLASSES OF PERSONS EMPLOYED IN INSURABLE EMPLOYMENT, AND INSURABLE IN LIKE MANNER AS EMPLOYMENT IN AGRICULTURE.

Persons employed in domestic service in any of the under-mentioned capacities except where the employed person is employed in any trade or business carried on for the purposes of gain :—

Boatman, coachman, gate-keeper, hunt servant, kennel man, lodge keeper, rabbit trapper, ranger.

**Insurance Industry Special Scheme.**

THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (INSURANCE INDUSTRY SPECIAL SCHEME) (VARIATION AND AMENDMENT) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1938, DATED 10TH JANUARY, 1938, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936 (26 GEO. V. AND 1 EDW. VIII, C. 30).

Whereas the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") by the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Industry Special Scheme) Orders (Northern Ireland), 1921 to 1937, approved for the purposes of Section 18 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, a Special Scheme for the Insurance Industry; and varied and amended the said Scheme, which Scheme, as so varied and amended, is hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme";

And whereas application has been made to the Ministry for a further variation and amendment of the provisions of the Scheme;

Now therefore the Ministry, by virtue of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (5) of Section 77 of the Unemployment Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order :

(1) The provisions of the Scheme shall be varied and amended as follows :—

Clause 52 of the Scheme shall have effect as if in sub-clause (1) (b) thereof for the words "the application for extended benefit" there were substituted the words "the date on which he was last insurably employed in the Insurance Industry."
