ORDER, DATED 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER, 1939, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE DESTRUCTIVE INSECTS AND PESTS ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1877 TO 1934 (40 AND 41 VICT., CH. 68; 7 EDW. 7, CH. 4; 24 AND 25 GEO. 5, CH. 4).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Destructive Insects and Pests Acts (Northern Ireland), 1877 to 1934, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

Short Title.

1.—This Order may be cited as the Black Scab in Potatoes (Northern Ireland) Order of 1939.

Amendment of the Black Scab in Potatoes (Northern Ireland)
Consolidation Order, 1930.

2.—The Black Scab in Potatoes (Northern Ireland) Consolidation Order, 1930, shall be read and have effect as if the following were included in the Sixth Schedule (Additional Districts in which the growing and planting of potatoes are restricted) thereto:

District No. 6 (Augher Safety Zone):

A district comprising the townland of Augher Tenements in the Barony of Clogher in the Administrative County of Tyrone.

Commencement.

3.—This Order shall come into operation on the first day of November, 1939.
