

(1)—The contribution payable by the Council of the County or County Borough in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the above-mentioned statute, towards the expenses of a youthful offender who has been sent to the Reformatory School pursuant to an Order shall, from the first day of April, Nineteen hundred and forty, and until varied by any subsequent Order, be at the rate of One Pound (£1) per week during such time as such youthful offender is detained in the Reformatory School.

(2)—Payment of the contribution as aforesaid shall be in arrear, and shall be made half-yearly by the Council of the County or County Borough in respect of the half years ending 30th September and 31st March, respectively, and shall be made not later than two months from the date of the claim for payment.

(3)—The Regulations made by the Ministry of Home Affairs and approved by the Ministry of Finance on the first day of July in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, are hereby revoked.

REGULATIONS, DATED THE 14TH DAY OF JULY, 1940, MADE BY THE
MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE MILK AND
MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934.

The Ministry of Agriculture, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

1.—These Regulations may be cited as the Butter and Margarine (Sales) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1940, and shall come into operation on the fourteenth day of July, 1940. Short Title and Commencement.

2.—The Butter and Margarine (Sales) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939, are hereby revoked. Revocation of previous Regulations.

3.—These Regulations and the Butter and Margarine (Sales) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939, and the Butter and Margarine (Sales) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939, shall be construed as one, and may be cited as the Butter and Margarine (Sales) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939 and 1940. Citation and Construction.
