TO THE COUNCIL OF THE BELFAST COUNTY BOROUGH; AND  
TO ALL OTHERS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

The Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf hereby prescribes with respect to the appointments hereinafter specified in the City Surveyor's Department of the Belfast County Borough Council, as follows, that is to say:—

- (1) No person shall be qualified to be appointed to any of the offices in the schedule to this Order unless he is in possession of the qualifications specified in the said schedule and in addition thereto satisfies the Ministry that:—

- (a) he has had adequate and suitable experience and has shown capacity in the practice of his profession as a Civil Engineer or Architect ;
- (b) his health and character are good ;
- (c) he is a natural born British subject and is the son of a father also a natural born British subject ;
- (d) he has, during the whole of the period of 5 years ending on the date of his appointment, been resident in the United Kingdom ;
- (e) he is not at the time of his appointment more than 45 years of age.

Provided that the Ministry may assent to a departure from the provisions of paragraph (e) of this Article in the case of a person holding office under the Belfast County Borough Council at the time of his appointment.

- (2) The Ministry may from time to time assent to any departure from the provisions of this Order, if, in its opinion, the adoption of such a course is desirable.
- (3) The provisions of this Order shall come into operation on the 14th day of July, 1941.
- (4) This order may be cited as the Belfast County Borough Council (City Surveyor's Staff Qualifications) Order, Northern Ireland, 1941.

## MALONE TRAINING SCHOOL.

### Regulations.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE, IN PURSUANCE OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 3 (3) OF THE MALONE TRAINING SCHOOL ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 3 (3) of the Malone Training School Act (Northern Ireland), 1926, (16 & 17 Geo. V Chapter 22), and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

- (1) The contribution payable by the Council of the County or County Borough in accordance with the provisions of subsection (3) of Section 3 of the above-mentioned statute, towards the expenses of a youthful offender who has been sent to the Reformatory School pursuant to an Order shall, from the first day of April, Nineteen Hundred and Forty-one, and until varied by any subsequent Order, be at the rate of Eighteen Shillings (18/-) per week during such time as such youthful offender is detained in the Reformatory School ;
- (2) Payment of the contribution as aforesaid shall be in arrear, and shall be made half-yearly by the Council of the County or
