# MALONE TRAINING SCHOOL.

## Regulations.

Regulations made by the Ministry of Home Affairs, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, in pursuance of the provisions of Section 3 (3) of the Malone Training School Act (Northern Ireland), 1926.

1941. No. 160.

The Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 3 (3) of the Malone Training School Act (Northern Ireland), 1926, (16 & 17 Geo. V Chapter 22), and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby-makes the following Regulations :—

(1) The contribution payable by the Council of the County or County Borough in accordance with the provisions of subsection (3) of Section 3 of the above-mentioned statute, towards the expenses of a youthful offender who has been sent to the Reformatory School pursuant to an Order shall, from the first day of April, Nineteen Hundred and Forty-one, and until varied by any subsequent Order, be at the rate of Eighteen Shillings (18/-) per week during such time as such youthful offender is detained in the Reformatory School ;

Payment of the contribution as aforesaid shall be in arrear, and shall be made half-yearly by the Council of the County or

County Borough in respect of the half-years ending 30th September and 31st March, respectively, and shall be made not later than two months from the date of the claim for payment;

(3) The Regulations made by the Ministry of Home Affairs, and approved by the Ministry of Finance on the Twenty-seventh day of June in the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty, are hereby revoked.
