REGULATIONS, DATED 18TH OCTOBER, 1941, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

1941. No. 190.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland acting jointly in pursuance of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1941, and shall be read as one with the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").
- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 2.—The following definition shall be added to paragraph (1) of regulation 3 of the principal regulations:—
 - "The Emergency Act of 1939" means the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939.
- 3.—The following additional sub-paragraph shall be inserted after sub-paragraph (d) of paragraph (1) of regulation 18 of the principal regulations:—
 - (dd) In the case of a person who is engaged in a war occupation prescribed for the purposes of section 1 of the Emergency Act of 1939 by the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (War Occupations) Regulations, 1940, or who is engaged in a war occupation prescribed for the purposes of section 2 of that Act and is disentitled to medical benefit by reason of the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (4) of regulation 6 of those regulations, at the rate of three shillings and sixpence.
- 4.—The following words shall be added at the end of paragraph (1) of regulation 18 of the principal regulations after the words "the first day of October, 1938":—"except in the case of sub-paragraph (dd) which shall come into operation on the third day of September, 1939."

5.—The provisions of section 3 of the Emergency Act of 1939, shall, as from the third day of September, 1939, apply to a deposit contributor as they apply to a member of an approved society, and accordingly references therein to an approved society shall be construed as including references to the Deposit Contributors Fund.

REGULATIONS, DATED DECEMBER 29TH, 1941, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE UNDER SECTION 160 (4) OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sub-section (4) of section 160 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1.—These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Joint Committee) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1941.
 - 2.—(1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—
 "the Act" means Part I of the National Health Insurance,
 Contributory Pensions and Workmen's Compensation Act, 1941,
 as applied to Northern Ireland by the National Health Insurance
 and Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1941;
