

(3) If no appeal is received from the school management committee within the said period of 21 days, the Ministry may confirm the proposed appointment or transfer if satisfied that it is otherwise in accordance with the Ministry's regulations.

4.—In any case of doubt or difficulty as to the interpretation of these regulations, or as to any claim, right or liability thereunder, the decision of the Ministry shall be final.

5.—These regulations shall take and have effect from 1st August, 1942, and as from that date the Regulations for Teachers' Appointments in Provided and Transferred Public Elementary Schools, 1934 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1934, No. 36) shall cease to have effect.

Technical Education : Certification, Salaries and Employment of Teachers.

REGULATIONS, DATED 1ST MAY, 1942, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS, 1923 TO 1940, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1942. No. 69.

The Regulations for Technical Teachers, 1937, Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1937, No. 101, as amended by Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1941, No. 74, which Regulations as so amended are hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Regulations" are hereby amended as follows :—

1.—These Regulations may be cited as "The Regulations for Technical Teachers, 1937, Amending Regulations No. 2, 1942.

2.—Articles 3 and 4 of the Regulations for Technical Teachers, 1937, Amending Regulations, No. 1, 1941 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1941, No. 74), are hereby repealed as from 31st March, 1941, and the following Article is substituted therefor :

3. (1) Where the salary payable to a teacher is within the rates set out in this sub-section there shall be payable to such teacher by the Managers by whom he is employed a temporary war bonus, the rates of which shall be as follows :—

Rate of Salary per annum as Teacher.

Rate of War Bonus per annum.

A. Period from 1st April, 1941, to 31st August, 1941.

Men.

Not over £262 10s 0d

£26

Over £262 10s 0d but under £275 10s 0d

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £288 10s 0d.

£275 10s 0d to £370

£13

Over £370 but under £383

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £383.

Women.

Not over £262 10s 0d

£19 10s 0d.

Over £262 10s 0d but under £271 12s 0d

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £282.

£271 12s 0d to £315

£10 8s 0d.

Over £315 but under £325 8s 0d

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £325 8s 0d.

B. Period from 1st September, 1941, onwards.

Men.

Not over £262 10s 0d

£26

Over £262 10s 0d but under £275 10s 0d

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £288 10s 0d.

£275 10s 0d to £525

£13

Over £525 but under £538

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £538.

Women.

Not over £262 10s 0d

£19 10s 0d.

Over £262 10s 0d but under £271 12s 0d

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £282.

£271 12s 0d to £525

£10 8s 0d.

Over £525 but under £535 8s 0d

Such rate as, when added to rate of salary, will bring total to £535 8s 0d.

(2) The bonus shall be payable in respect of recognised service rendered during the periods specified in sub-section (1) of this Article, and shall not be reckonable for the purposes of the Superannuation Scheme.

(3) For the purposes of these Amending Regulations the term "Salary" as defined in the Principal Regulations shall

be deemed not to include any war bonus paid to the teacher either under sub-section (1) above or under the Principal Regulations.

3.—These Regulations shall henceforth be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.

Technical Teachers' War Service.

REGULATIONS, DATED 15TH JULY, 1942, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE 'TEACHERS' SALARIES AND SUPERANNUATION (WAR SERVICE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1939.

1942. No. 123.

1.—These Regulations may be cited as the Technical Teachers' War Service Regulations, 1940, Amending Regulations, No. 1, 1942.

2.—The Technical Teachers' War Service Regulations, 1940, (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1940, No. 30) which Regulations are hereinafter referred to as the "said Regulations" are hereby amended as follows :—

3.—Sub-section (c) of Article 2 of the said Regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the words "part-time teacher" after the words "full-time teacher."

After sub-section (e) of Article 2 of the said Regulations the following sub-section is hereby inserted :—

(ee) A "superannuated teacher" is a person who is in receipt of a pension under a Superannuation Scheme framed in pursuance of Section 70 of the Education Act, Northern Ireland, 1923, or a teacher who is in receipt of a pension under the provisions of Section 8 of the Local Government (Ireland) Act, 1919.

Sub-section (g) of Article 2 of the said Regulations is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor :—

(g) A "temporary war-time teacher" means a person (including a superannuated teacher) who

(1) at the date of these Regulations was employed as a temporary teacher or as a substitute teacher under the Technical Teachers' War Service Regulations, 1940 ;
