THE PUBLIC SECURITY (CHURCH BELLS) (REVOCATION) ORDER
(NORTHERN IRELAND), 1943, DATED 27TH MAY, 1943, MADE BY THE
MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER
SECTION 3 (3) OF THE MINISTRIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1940.

WHEREAS it is provided by Sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the Minis-
tries Act (Northern Ireland), 1940, that any Order made under the said
Act may be revoked by a subsequent Order :

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Public Security for Northern Ireland
made on the 22nd day of April, 1943, an Order under the said Act
entitled the Public Security (Church Bells) (No. 2) Order (Northern
Ireland), 1943 (a)

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the said Order should now be
revoked :

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry of Public Security for Northern
Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the said Act and
of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders that the said
Order shall be revoked.
