

4.—Notwithstanding anything contained in Article 126 of the Principal Regulations, the salary of a teacher recognised as locum tenens principal or locum tenens assistant, not fully qualified, shall be at the rate of £145 per annum in respect of service given as such on and after 1st April, 1944.

5.—The rate of salary payable under Article 126 of the Principal Regulations to a locum tenens junior assistant mistress shall, in respect of service given as such on and after 1st April, 1944, be increased by twenty-five per cent. : Provided that the salary of a trained locum tenens junior assistant mistress shall not thereby be increased beyond £145 per annum.

6.—Article 127 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended, with effect from 1st April, 1944, by the deletion of the sentence beginning “ If the teacher”.

7.—Clause (c) of Article 120 is amended, with effect from 1st April, 1944, as follows :—

- (a) by the substitution of “ £145 ” for “ £120 ” in lines 3 and 4 ;
- (b) by the substitution of “ £125 ” and “ £118 15s.” for “ £100 ” and “ £95 ”, respectively, in line 4.

8.—These regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.

REGULATIONS, DATED 20TH NOVEMBER, 1944, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE TEACHERS' SALARIES AND SUPERANNUATION (WAR SERVICE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1939, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1944. No. 109.

1.—These regulations may be cited as the Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations, 1940, Amending Regulations, No. 4, 1944.

2.—The Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations, 1940 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1940,

No. 16), as amended by Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1941, No. 45 ; 1942, No. 42 ; and 1942, No. 135 ; which Regulations, as so amended, are hereinafter referred to as the " said Regulations ", are hereby amended as follows :—

3.—(1) Sub-section (1) of Section (c) of Article 4 of the said Regulations is hereby amended as follows :—

by the deletion of the words " £120 a year " and the substitution therefor in respect of service given on and after 1st April, 1944, of the words " £145 a year ".

(2) Sub-section (4) of Section (c) of Article 4 of the said Regulations is hereby amended with effect from 1st April, 1942, by the insertion after " instruction." in line 5 of the following words :—

" He shall also be eligible to receive Compensation Grant on the terms and conditions which would be applicable to him in accordance with the provisions of the Principal Regulations if he were serving as principal or assistant teacher in the school."

4.—These Regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations, 1940.

REGULATIONS, DATED 15TH JANUARY, 1944, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS, 1923 TO 1942, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1.—These Regulations may be cited as " The Regulations for Secondary Teachers, Northern Ireland, 1937, No. 2, Amending Regulations, No. 6, 1944 ".

2.—The Regulations for Secondary Teachers, Northern Ireland, 1937, No. 2, Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1937, No. 89, as amended by Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1941, Nos. 71 and 212 ; 1942, No. 74, 1943, Nos. 39 and 68, which Regulations as so amended are hereinafter referred to as the " Principal Regulations " are hereby amended as follows :—
