3.—Article 15 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition of the following clause after the words "£145 per annum (together with, in the case of a Superintendent, Principal's Grant)":—

The rate of salary payable to a Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent appointed under Article 13 (b) of the Principal Regulations shall in respect of service as such, given on and after 1st April, 1944, be increased by twenty-five per cent. : save that the increase shall not be such as to raise the salary of the said Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent above that to which a Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent of the same length of service who was recognised under Article 13 (a) of the Principal Regulations would be entitled.

4.—These Regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.
