ORDER, DATED 6TH MARCH, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICUL-TURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER REGULATION 55 OF THE Defence (General) Regulations, 1939,* as having effect by VIRTUE OF THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS) Act. 1945 (a).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland (in this Order referred to as "the Ministry") by virtue and in exercise of the powers under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, delegated to it by the Delegation of the Control of Binder Twine in Northern Ireland (Supply) (No. 1) Order, 1944 (b), made by the Minister of Supply under Regulation 55 of the said Regulations, and by virtue of the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) Act, 1945, and an Order in Council made thereunder (a), hereby orders and directs as follows:

Acquisition and disposal of binder twine

- 1. No person in Northern Ireland shall—
 - (1) acquire or agree or offer to acquire any unused binder twine; except-

- (a) a farmer or an agricultural contractor who delivers to the person from whom he acquires or agrees or offers to acquire that binder twine a Farmer's Binder Twine Acquisition Note or an Agricultural Contractor's Binder Twine Acquisition Note; or,
- (b) under authority of and in accordance with a licence granted by the Ministry; or
- (2) dispose of or agree or offer to dispose of any unused binder twine; except—
 - (a) to a farmer or an agricultural contractor who has delivered to him the appropriate Binder Twine Acquisition Note; or
 - (b) to a person who is authorised to acquire that material from him by virtue of a licence granted by the Ministry;
 or
 - (c) under authority of and in accordance with a licence granted by the Ministry; or
 - (d) by virtue of a licence granted by the Minister of Supply under the British Binder Twine Order

provided that nothing in this Article shall prohibit or restrict any farmer from delivering agricultural produce tied by him with used binder twine or any person from taking delivery of or redelivering such produce so tied.

- 2. No person shall treat, use or consume any unused binder twine; except—'
 - (a) a farmer or an agricultural contractor for use in a selfbinding harvesting machine or a trussing machine; or
 - (b) for binding beets of flax; or
 - (c) under the authority of and in accordance with a licence granted by the Ministry.
- 3.—(1) The holder of any licence granted under this Order shall comply with any conditions contained or incorporated in that licence.
 - (2) If any licence granted under this Order is revoked or suspended by the Ministry the holder of that licence shall forthwith deliver up that licence to or as directed by the Ministry.
- 4.—(1) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings assigned to them:—
 - "Binder Twine" means any cord, string, twine or like material made wholly of sisal or of sisal and jute which has only a single yarn and is suitable for use in any self-binding harvesting machine.
 - "Farmer's Binder Twine Acquisition Note" means a document in the form of the acquisition note specified in

Part I of the Schedule to this Order completed and dated and signed as required by the terms of that note.

- "Agricultural Contractor's Binder Twine Acquisition Note" means a document in the form of the acquisition note specified in Part II of the Schedule to this Order completed and dated and signed as required by the terms of that note.
- "British Binder Twine Order" means any Order of the Minister of Supply in force for the time being in Great Britain relating to the control of binder twine.
- (2) In this Order—
 - (a) reference to offers to acquire or dispose of shall be construed respectively as including reference to invitations of offers to dispose of or acquire; and
 - (b) the expression "acquire" includes the acquisition, and the expression "dispose of "includes the disposal of
 - (i) ownership or any proprietary interest; or
 - (ii) the right to possession; or
 - (iii) possession whether or not accompanied by any acquisition or disposal of ownership or of any proprietary interest or of the right to possession.
- (3) For the purpose of this Order where any article is acquired by or disposed of to a carrier or warehouseman or servant acting in the ordinary course of his business or employment as such, that article shall be deemed to be acquired by or disposed of to the person on whose behalf or to whose order the carrier or warehouseman or servant so acquires that article and not by or to the carrier or warehouseman or servant and where any article is acquired from or disposed of by a carrier or warehouseman or servant as aforesaid that article shall be deemed to be acquired from or disposed of by the person on whose behalf or by whose order the carrier or warehouseman or servant so disposes of that article and not from or by the carrier or warehouseman or servant.
- 5. The Binder Twine Control (Northern Ireland) Order, 1944,* is hereby revoked provided that any licence granted under that Order shall be deemed to be a licence granted under this Order.
- 6. This Order may be cited as the Binder Twine Control (Northern Ireland) Order, 1946, and shall come into force on the twentieth day of March, Nineteen hundred and forty-six.

Explanatory Note.	
The above Order revokes and remakes with amendments the Binder Twine Control (Northern Ireland) Order, 1944, so that authorisations by the Ministry of Agriculture, for Northern Ireland for the acquisition of unused binder twine are abolished, and farmers can now obtain unused binder twine on their own acquisition notes.	•
The Order also provides for a similar relaxation of the control of unused binder twine supplies to agricultural contractors who in Northern Ireland harvest and truss a substantial proportion of the crops.
