

REGULATIONS, DATED THE 1ST DAY OF APRIL, 1946, MADE BY THE
MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNDER THE PUBLIC
HEALTH (TUBERCULOSIS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1946.

The Ministry of Health and Local Government for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Public Health (Tuberculosis) Act (Northern Ireland), 1946 (hereinafter called "the Act") hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Tuberculosis) (Appointed Day No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1946.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations in like manner as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The provisions of the Act specified in the Schedule hereto shall come into operation on the date of these Regulations.
