The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by sections 65, 69 and 77 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Payment of Grants) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.
 - (2) These Regulations shall have effect as from 1st August, 1947.
- 2. A grant may be paid by the Ministry to the governing body of a recognised school equal to one-half of the expenditure incurred by such governing body in the employment of a person, other than a teacher, who is engaged, in accordance with arrangements approved by the Ministry, for the purpose of giving assistance in the teaching of modern languages:

Provided that

- (a) the grant in respect of the employment of any such person shall not exceed the sum of £90 in any school year; and
- (b) in the case of a school which is under the management of a local education authority, these Regulations shall cease to have effect in respect of the employment of any such person after 31st March, 1948.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Sections 65, 69

and 77 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Secondary Schools (Payment of Grants) (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1947.
- (2) In these Regulations the expression "the principal Regulations" means the Secondary School Grants Regulations, 1935, as amended by subsequent Regulations other than these Regulations.
- (3) These Regulations shall be construed as one with the principal Regulations.
- 2. In the case of a school which is under the management of a local education authority:—
 - (a) no grant shall be payable by the Ministry to the governing body in respect of the attendances of pupils during the period 1st April to 31st July, 1948.
 - (b) the grant in respect of the attendances of pupils during the period commencing 1st August, 1947, and ending 31st March, 1948, shall be an amount equivalent to two-thirds of the sum which would have been paid in accordance with the provisions of the principal Regulations in respect of the school year ending 31st July, 1948, if this Regulation had not come into operation.
