- 2. This Order may be cited as the Permits for Mechanically-Propelled Vehicles (Expiry of Enactments) Order (Northern Ireland), 1947.

REGULATIONS, DATED THE 20TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1947, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1926 TO 1945.

The Ministry of Commerce, in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Acts (Northern Ireland), 1926 to 1945, and of all other powers in this behalf thereunto enabling it, hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say:—

- 1. The Motor Cars (Use and Construction) Regulations, 1934, as amended shall have effect as if in the proviso to Regulation 46, and in Regulation 48 thereof, respectively, the date "1st January, 1949" were substituted for the date "1st January, 1948".
- 2. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Cars (Use and Construction) (Amendment) (Northern Ireland) Regulations, 1947.
